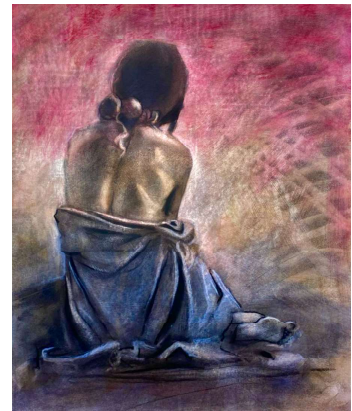
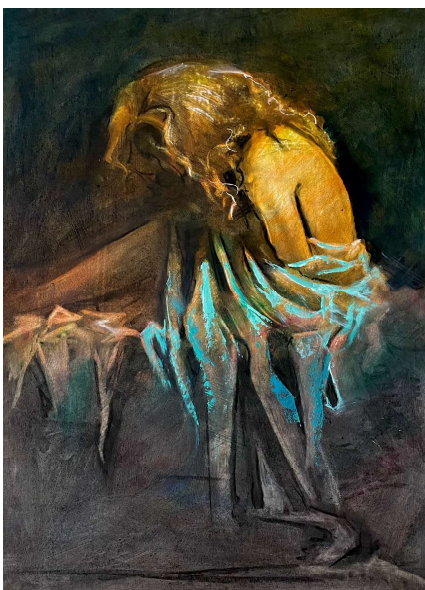


Stainbeck Arts Club Newsletter
